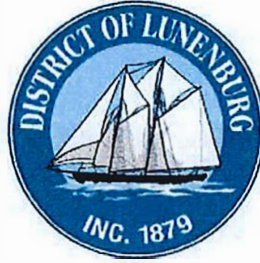

### **Re: Deer Warning Sign Request – Northwest Road (Highway 324)**

At the February 12th, 2019 Municipal Council meeting of the Municipality of the District of Lunenburg, Council made a motion, accepting the recommendation of the Police Advisory Board to write to your department requesting the placement of warning signage regarding deer at the on the Northwest Road (Highway 324).

Watch for Wildlife has identified several locations on this road that could benefit from warning signage (see below). The area of most concern appears to be the wooded section between the Fauxburg Road and Civic #800.

#### **Towards Blockhouse**

- The crest of the hill near Corkum's Towing has been the site of numerous collisions and is a deer crossing.
- The hill before Martin's Brook is a dangerous section of regular crossings and collision sites
- Just north of Fauxburg Rd where fields are adjacent, and the brook crossing, is another site of collisions and crossings.

#### **Towards Lunenburg**

- On the other side of the hill before the water crossing and fields above Fauxburg Rd
- On the flat where the farm with large fields is on the right and forest on the left (before Old Northwest Road)
- On the crest of the hill past Schnare's Crossing near Corkum's Towing
