7. New Business

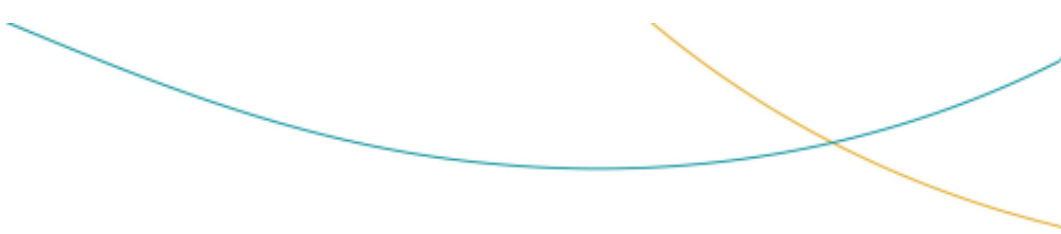
