Hi again everyone,

It sounds like there is some confusion about this. The last time we did this in the Spring, the meeting was hosted in Chester and the CAO asked me to draft something as follow up to the Councils outlining the recommendations, but he signed it. I made an assumption that the hosts of the meeting would follow up. I apologize if I should have stepped into facilitate this.

The key information is as follows:

The Lunenburg County Accessibility Advisory Committee (LCAAC) currently has four vacancies for community members. Twenty-two applications were received from community members by the July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022 deadline. The LCAAC Terms of Reference indicate that new terms will be three years in length. However, as one of the vacant positions is due to the death of a previous member, the replacement member will serve a term expiring December 2022, completing the existing term.

The Lunenburg County Accessibility Nominating Committee comprised of the Mayors and Wardens of the five Lunenburg County municipalities (or their designates) has reviewed the applications and makes the following recommendation to the five Municipal Councils in Lunenburg County:

To reappoint Louise Hopper to the Lunenburg County Accessibility Advisory Committee for a term expiring December 2023, to appoint Dylan Robar and Teresa Alexander-Arab, and to reappoint Peggy McCalla to the Lunenburg County Accessibility Advisory Committee for three-year terms.

I hope that clarified things. Please let me know if I need to do more.
