1. Call to Order

Mayor Bolivar-Getson called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m. and began by acknowledging that the meeting was held in Mi'kma'ki, the ancestral and unceded territory of the Mi'kmaq people.

2. Removal of States of Local Emergency – Shingle Mill Road, Martins River

Mr. MacEwan reviewed the details of the state of emergency declarations, resulting from the flooding, that were called for both the Rayport Campground on Shingle Mill Road and subsequently all of the properties on Shingle Mill Road, north of Highway 103. He reported that Nova Scotia Department of Public Works had advised that Shingle Mills Road was reopened and recommended that the local state of emergency be terminated.

2023-138 Moved by Councillor DeLong, seconded by Councillor Bell that Municipal Council lift the State of Local Emergency for all of Shingle Mill Road, Martins River, and that the Mayor be authorized to execute, Form 7 – Termination of a State of Local Emergency on or after 11:45 a.m., July 27, 2023. Carried unanimously.


Mandatory evacuation of the campground due to flooding of Shingle Mill Road resulting in the campground being completely inaccessible.




